- δ Declaration of results will be through a live event on Zoom platform on 28th of November 2020 at 2:00 pm. The link for the same will be shared beforehand.
- $\delta\,$ Three categories for participation are
 - > C1- Sub Junior (III to V)
 - C2- Junior (VI to VIII)
 - C3- Senior (IX to XII)
- $\delta\,$ e-certificates will be issued to all winners and participants.
- δ One student can participate in one event only.
