Dear Parent,

The Directorate of Education, Govt. of NCT of Delhi has issued instructions through Circular No. DE.5/43/04/Exam/2019-20/93-103, dated 29th January, 2021 to call students of classes IX and XI to school to conduct certain specified activities pertaining to Academics, Practical work and Examination. This is subject to your consent, following the enclosed Standard Operating Procedure. These classes will help your ward prepare well for the examination. The specific dates and schedule of the classes will be informed to you by 6th February, 2021. The timings for these classes will be 8:20 a.m. -1 p.m. No transport facility will be provided by the school.

Here, I wish to bring the following information to your attention:-

- 1. Offline teaching for classes IX and XI will be held three days a week i.e. Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. Each section will be divided in a way that there are only 15 students in a classroom at any given time. If there are more children on a particular day, the class will be moved into bigger premises so that social distancing can be maintained.
- 2. Most classes have a maximum strength of 45. Hence, when divided into groups of 15 each, three groups will be created and each group will be coming to school for only one day in a week. Hence, please understand that your child will come to school based on the class distribution on either Monday, Wednesday or Thursday.

On Tuesday and Friday, all classes will be held online as before. You may also note that the school plans to hold proper full length offline Annual Examination for classes IX & XI from 1st March, 2021. It is imperative that your child starts coming to school from next week.

On a personal note it is my fervent and heartfelt request to encourage your child to come to school. This will be a time for re-engaging the child towards renewed learning and overall development. Therefore, kindly submit your consent to the Class Teacher on her/his mail address by 5th February, 2021.

- 3. The Standard Operating Procedure as instructed by the Government, shall be adhered to and all safety precautions shall be taken.

- 5. All students must attend school in uniform.

- 8. Students with cough, cold, fever or any other ailment must not be sent to school during this time.
- 9. Students must not carry a mobile phone with them. If found, it will be confiscated.
- 10. Students must carry a 'hard copy' of the consent form with them on the first day.
- 11. Class IX students will enter and exit the school from Gate No. 3 (near the DDA park).
- 12. Class XI students will enter and exit the school from Gate No. 2 (near the Traffic signal).
- 13. We seek your cooperation to bring back your ward to School in a safe environment and ensure that your ward receives the best preparation possible.
