Participation Rules for Director's Cut

- 1. Each school may send one team comprising four members from classes IX to XII.
- 2. The content should be original. Downloaded movies will be disqualified.
- 3. The presentation must contain varied media content –live videos, images, special effects, music etc. It should not be in the form of PPT.
- 4. All the teams must bring their movie to the venue in a CD/pen drive/hard disk on the day of the event.
- 5. Experts from a wide range of spheres will be invited to judge all the movies.
- 6. Screening will be followed by comments of the Judges and an interactive session on the topic.
- 7. The teams can create their movies using any Multimedia Software. The movie will then have to be published/converted to movie format .avi, .wmv, .mov, .m4v etc..
- 8. There will be no live speaking while the movie is running (other than the introduction/conclusion which can happen either before the movie starts or after it concludes).
- 9. The duration of the movie should not exceed 8 minutes. A one-minute optional live introduction/conclusion by the team members can be made by the team with in this time.
- 10. The movie will be judged on content, scripting, originality, use of varied multimedia tools, overall composition and creativity. The top 3 teams will be awarded after the final round.

Participation Rules

- All matches should be played via 'Friendly Match'.
- Players are allowed to play with club and country teams but games should only be club Vs club or country Vs country.
- The home player will have the choice to play with club or country teams.
- Only tactical defense is permitted i.e. defending and attacking is fully manual.

Settings : Standard settings

Match duration : 12 minutes (6 minutes per half)

Game speed : Normal

Participation Rules

- The language used will be python.
- There will be 4 questions to be solved in 2 hours.
- One more Bonus Question will be given, if a team submits their first four questions before time limit.
- The correct output as well as the time of submission for the first four questions will be checked.
- The final question if correctly solved will fetch bonus points, but wrong submission of the bonus question will yield negative points.
